GBDHA JOINS THE NATIONAL COUNCIL ON SKIN CANCER PREVENTION

Due to the generosity of the Greater Baltimore Dental Hygienists' Association, I am pleased to represent our Association as a Member of the **National Council on Skin Cancer Prevention**. This organization has been a positive force for almost a decade and is now comprised of 30 member organizations, whose collective purpose is to facilitate skin cancer awareness on a national basis through education and promotion of sun safe behaviors. The Council meets semi-annually in April and November in Washington, DC.

For those interested in keeping updated in sun safety issues, you are invited to the **NCSCP** web site at <http://www.skincancerprevention.org>. This is a great resource to learn about tanning beds (not such a good thing, despite their advertising), sunscreens and sun-protective clothing, and protective outdoor covers for playgrounds or your own backyard (all very good things and highly recommended).

Last year for the first time, the **NCSCP** initiated a program called **"Don't Fry Day"** held on the **Friday before Memorial Day** as a way to kick off the summer sun and fun days with a strong message of sun safety. As much as we all enjoy sunny summer days, now winding to a close, we must also keep in mind the danger of those sunny UVA and UVB rays. It is crucial to understand that *any* change in your skin, whether burned or slightly tanned, is a sign of UV damage – much as we might admire a tan. As dental hygienists we are charged with providing our patients with a thorough extra- and intra-oral examination. To this end, we would do well to keep in mind that melanoma (the most fatal of skin cancers) continues to rise significantly, at a rate faster than any of the seven most common cancers. Moreover, melanoma is the second most common form of cancer for young adults 15-29 years of age. In addition, in the last 30 years, the number of women under age 40 diagnosed with basal cell carcinoma has more than doubled while the squamous cell carcinoma rate has also increased significantly. Skin cancer is not just for old people!! Keep this in mind as you complete your extra- and intra-oral cancer examination for *all* of your patients, regardless of age.
